Health Protection and Promotion Act, R.S.O. 1990

Animals must be in good health and have not been vaccinated within the previous year. Please have all animals restrained!

Rabies in Lambton County

2016

- 1 bat tested positive for rabies
- 346 animal exposure investigations were conducted
- 35 people received post-exposure rabies vaccine
- 35 compulsory rabies vaccination letters were issues to pet owners whose pets were involved in biting incidents.

2015

- Zero rabies positive animals in Lambton County
- 374 animal exposure investigations were conducted
- 40 people received post-exposure rabies vaccine
- 63 compulsory rabies vaccination letters were issued to pet owners whose pets were involved in biting incidents

2014

- Zero rabies positive animals in Lambton County
- 373 animal exposure investigations were conducted
- 52 people received post-exposure rabies vaccine
- 67 compulsory rabies vaccination letters were issued to pet owners whose pets were involved in biting incidents

2013

- 3 bats tested positive for rabies
- 346 animal exposure investigations were conducted
- 21 people received post exposure rabies vaccine
- 46 compulsory rabies vaccination letters were issued to pet owners whose pets were involved in biting incidents
