MINUTES

OCTOBER 20 2015

A meeting of the Council of the Corporation of the Township of Enniskillen was held on Tuesday October 20 2015 at 7:00 pm.

Mayor Marriott chaired the meeting.

Pecuniary Interest

Mayor Marriott requested that each member of Council declare an interest at the appropriate time within the agenda where an interest may exist.

A. Minutes

B. Interview:

Roads: Update on McKenzie Drain Bridge, Update on Salt shed, The Road Superintendent noted that the McKenzie Drain Bridge on Rokeby Line was started on October 14 and completed with the road open on the evening of October 16 2015. He reported that the water in the area had been shut off on October 14 while the culvert was replaced.

The Road Superintendent noted that the quonset building had been demolished today. He noted that a ramp to the new salt building would be completed next. The new fuel storage tanks were to be received in the next week. He reported that trucks were being sent for their annual inspection. A discussion took place in regards to a ribbon cutting for the new salt shed. Once the final work was completed a date would be set for early November. The Road Superintendent noted that the roads tractor had been replaced.

Drainage: Plowing Match Road site meeting

The Road Superintendent reported on the site meeting that had been held concerning a proposed drainage works on Plowing Match Road north of Rokeby Line. The property owners had agreed to address the matter by entering into a mutual agreement drain. The property owners had agreed to have work undertaken to create a 150 foot swale on the Thrower property to provide outlet for water from the three McLean properties and that of Allan Anderson. The Drainage Superintendent had agreed to prepare the mutual agreement.

Water:

The Clerk reported that water bills had been circulated and collections were underway. The pressure reduction valve for Oil Springs at the reservoir had been installed today.
