Budget Memo 2025

Mrs. Poland reviewed the memo prepared outlining increases in the 2025 tax levy. It was noted that the levy would provide a surplus for the expenditures required in 2026 regarding the Black Creek Bridge on Marthaville Road and the costs associated with the Petrolia North Enniskillen Fire Department.

Moved by Councillor Van Dun Seconded by Councillor Krall That the 2025 Township general levy be increased by \$150,000 and the fire levy be increased by \$75,000. Carried.

Water: Memo Dedicated Locator Agreement

Mrs. Poland explained to Council that G-Tel was the dedicated locator for a fiber optic project located in Brooke-Alvinston Township. She noted that the project did not currently affect any Township infrastructure for locate purposes.

Mrs. Poland recommended that Council authorize the agreement with G-Tel in the event that locates would affect Township infrastructure.
