The Township of Enniskillen is pleased to introduce paperless billing for tax notices and water bills.

Due to the possibility of a Canada Post strike, we will be implementing our paperless billing sooner than anticipated, as the strike may impact the delivery of Municipal paper billings.

eBilling

For Enniskillen property owners only:

Please complete the online Property Taxes & Water Billings form to register for paperless billing. By signing up for eBilling, you will receive your property tax and water bill in a PDF format to the email address that you provide to us.

For Non-Resident water customers:

Please complete the online Water Bill form to register for paperless billing. By signing up for eBilling, you will receive your water bill in a PDF format to the email address that you provide.

If you completed the form, your bills will continue to be eBilled with or without a postal strike.

If you do not wish to sign up for eBilling, your bills will still be mailed. The Canada Post strike action may impact the delivery of Municipal paper billing. Other Contingency Options to Receive your bill in the event of a postal strike:

- 1. Collect your paper bill in person at the Municipal Office (4465 Rokeby Line, Petrolia ON)
- 2. Call the Municipal Office to request your tax or water bill amount over the phone (519-882-2490)

Payment methods

We strongly discourage making payments through postal services during the Canada Post strike, as mailed payments may not be received by the Municipality before the due date and you may face late charges.

There are several contingency options available for residents and businesses to ensure their payments are made:

- 1.Internet or Telephone Banking
- 2. In Person at the municipal office cash, cheque or debit
- 3. Automated Banking Machines / Bank Teller at your branch

Please note, it is the recipient's responsibility to ensure that any amount due is paid by the due date. During the postal service disruption, water bills and tax notices will continue to be issued and the payment due dates will remain unchanged. For those who receive their bills by mail, it is recommended to sign up for paperless billing to ensure you do not miss a payment deadline.
