Are due last business days of Apr, Jul & Oct
If you are paying a lump sum for your taxes online, with multiple properties, you need to use the account number for each property. The account number for taxes and water are different.



due dates are the last business day of Feb, June, & Oct. Please ensure the remote is accessible, clear from bushes, decks, etc.

Water Rates effective Jan. 15, 2025 \$2.14 per cubic meter.

### **Open Burning**



Farmers are able to burn brush and material permitted for farm purposes provided that appropriate notification is given. If you plan to have an open burn, it is necessary to contact the municipal office between the hours of 8:30 am and 4:30 pm with 24 hours' notice. When completed, staff will notify the appropriate fire department. Open burning allowed in daylight hours only. If no notification is provided you may receive a bill for having the fire department attend an open burn.

Ensure that 9-1-1 signs remain visible.
