## TAX Installments

Are due last business days of April, July & October. If you are paying a lump sum for your taxes online, with multiple properties, you need to use the account number for each property. The account number for taxes and water are different.



## Water Bill

**Due dates are the last business day of February, June, & October**  
**Please ensure the remote is accessible, clear from bushes, decks, etc.**

Water Rates effective Jan. 15, 2026  
\$2.15 per cubic meter.  
\$56.00 Administration fee per billing.  
\$0.30 per cubic meter for hydro for customers in the LaSalle pump station area.  
Oil City sewer rates are \$43.00 / month.

## Open Burning



Farmers are able to burn brush and material permitted for farm purposes provided that appropriate notification is given. **If you plan to have an open burn, it is necessary to contact the municipal office between the hours of 8:30 am and 4:30 pm with 24 hours' notice.** When completed, staff will notify the appropriate fire department. Open burning allowed in daylight hours only. If no notification is provided you may receive a bill for having the fire department attend an open burn. Ensure that 9-1-1 signs remain visible.


